Research internship

Mandatory part of the master



Internship: place in curriculum

Period 1: Sept. until Oct. \rightarrow 2 courses

Period 2: Oct. until Dec. \rightarrow 2 courses

Period 3 (but accessible throughout the year): Academic Skills (Gill ten Hoor)

- Meet your mentors 1, 2, 3 (last week of Sept, Oct, Nov)
- Search for internship topics/supervisors Oct/Nov/DecConceptualize content of proposal with supervisors
- Write research proposal in January

>> If prerequisites are met (8 credits from core courses, P1&P2)
>> Periods 4-6 (February to July/August)

>> earliest period 4 (or agreed start date + 8 credits)

What is the research internship?

Several types of possible internships

- Own empirical research
- Collectively gathering data
- Working with existing data provided by supervisor (e.g. panel datasets, meta-analyses, computational modeling)
- Theoretical review (using Cochrane guidelines of review)

How to find internship positions II

Contact staff at CN (FPN) by mail, after tutorial, after lecture, ...

- Internal
- External

Contact other labs/research groups yourself

- More difficult/less successful
- CV + "motivation"
- Check lab website and contact a secretary, Postdoc (or PhD) for higher chance of replies





- Maastricht University, with one of the staff members
- External institute in the Netherlands (e.g. other university)
- External institute abroad (e.g. university abroad)

Keep in mind:

- **Backup plan** (signed by you and supervisors)
 - required to start internship
- Check askpsy for current advice regarding destination



Internship Supervision/Assessment I

- You always need **2 supervisors**
- 1 is always from UM

Internal internship

To be first supervisor a PhD degree is required, however exceptions are made and:

- PhD students and Senior lecturers without a Phd holding a UTQ qualification "assessment" AND having supervised two research internships can also be first supervisor.
- Phd students holding a UTQ qualification 'assessment' and UM lecturers without a PhD can be second supervisor



Internship Supervision/Assessment II

External internship

- → If supervisor there has PhD degree or a track record showing experience in conducting research and writing scientific papers:
 - \rightarrow Then that person can be the 1st supervisor/assessor.
 - → You need a second assessor from UM that needs to meet the same criteria as for an internal internship
- \rightarrow If the external supervisor does NOT meet the criteria:
 - → they can assess the practical part and inform the internal supervisor about the student's performance and grade
 - → You need a second assessor from UM that needs to meet the same criteria as for an internal internship



Workload research internship period

• In total 33.5 EC (28 hours workload per EC)

Of which

- Research Proposal 4.5 EC
- Research Internship 19 EC = 532h, of which 7 are graded (GPA)
- Master Thesis 10 EC

• Excl. academic skills (0.5) & electives (6 credits)



Master's thesis

- Individually written, in English.
- Meets formal guidelines (e.g., minimum length of words), and the content guidelines.

Ethical approval

- ERCPN will no longer review external student research projects which are not part of regular FPN research
- Students and their (FPN) supervisors are also no longer required to present to the ERCPN approval letters of external ethical review
- A standard clause will be added to the internship contracts, stating that the scientific research as part of the internship is carried out according to the applicable ethical standards
- Students shall include in their Research Proposal how ethical approval is or will be obtained by the person with the primary responsibility for the design and procedure.
- >> Ethical approval is needed!

- The application form is **NOT** the contract!
- The application form is necessary to make the contract
- Supervisors and student check info and receive contract per email
- Information required: supervisors (1st and 2nd) + mail address, preliminary title, start/end date, back-up plan, emergency contact, institute address

The IRO **doesn't have formal agreements for internship purposes**, nor a list of internship options. The **IRO cannot mediate in finding an internship abroad**. Always get in touch with your internship coordinator, to discuss how to proceed.



Scholarships

Erasmus+ scholarship (internship within EU).

See <u>www.askpsy.nl/iro/grant-opportunities</u> for information on Erasmus+ scholarships for 2023/24 (online application form, conditions, deadlines). Lowest priority for internships in country of origin.

Application deadline: 6 weeks prior to the start of your internship

No FPN scholarships (for internships outside EU)

Other scholarships? See <u>www.beursopener.nl</u>; <u>www.european-funding-guide.eu</u>, <u>www.scholarshipportal.com</u>.

Note: Be careful making preparations involving costs until there's certainty on whether your physical internship can take place!



Important notes!

- Ask your host institution whether they charge tuition/service fees for visiting students (e.g. interns). EU students may be exempted by registering for the 'Erasmus + Traineeship scheme'.
- You have to remain registered and pay tuition fees to UM throughout your entire studies (incl. internship period).
 No valid registration = no validation (ECTS) of your internship!
- Need an official document confirming your registration at UM, and that the internship is an official part of your curriculum? Ask the FPN Board of Examiners for a 'Internship Abroad Statement' through <u>www.askpsy.nl/contact</u>

Requirements research internship

- The internship can only be started when at least 8 credits of the core courses from period 1 and 2 are passed.
 - the internship starts at the first of the month after which 8 credits have been obtained, not earlier than P4.

If you deviate from the above without permission from the Board of Examiners, the result of the part in question can be declared invalid.



Important

- At least a month before you start your internship you have to fill out the internship application form.
- When you meet the requirements for the internship a contract will be made up, which is signed by all parties.

If you don't apply for the internship, it will be considered illegal, and can be declared invalid.

Thesis in Collent

When the final thesis is uploaded in Collent:

- Your supervisors will get an automatic notification
- At the 15th working day upon uploading, supervisors will get a reminder that the deadline for assessing is approaching
- If necessary the Education Office will send out a second reminder to supervisors to remind them of the deadline for assessing your thesis
